Behavior Expectations

To ensure the all of our guests have a great time at WOW, it is important that teachers, students and chaperones abide by the following behavior guidelines. By requesting a field experience at Wonders of Wildlife you agree to enforce these behaviors with your students and chaperones. If you permit your students to visit Bass Pro Shops located directly next door to WOW, the same behavior guidelines apply. Please review the following behavior guidelines with your students and chaperones.



- 1. Stay with your class/group.** Students must stay with their teacher/chaperone at all times. This includes lunch breaks, bathroom breaks, and trips into the Bass Pro Shops store.
- 2. Be respectful of other guests.** Please use your indoor voice and refrain from yelling. When possible, use the stairs and the escalators, leaving the elevators available for those who need them.
- 3. Safety First.** For your safety, always face forward on the escalators and keep one hand on the railing. Walk; do not run through any area of WOW.
- 4. Respect the Wonders of Wildlife exhibits and facility.** Please use notebooks or clipboards to write against, do not use walls, windows or exhibit signage. Climbing on exhibit rocks, ledges or railings is prohibited.
- 5. Respect the animals.** At the touch exhibits, touch the animals gently with two fingers, avoiding the animal's eyes, mouth, and gills. WOW staff and volunteers will be present to demonstrate the proper technique. Do not remove the animal from its exhibit or lift it out of the water. Do not disturb the animals by tapping on the windows.
- 6. Do not feed the animals.** Only feed the animals where our staff has supplied food. Do not feed any animal any item that has been purchased from concessions, brought from home, or found on the ground as it could be harmful to them.
- 7. Do not use flash photography.** We would love for you to share your experience at Wonders of Wildlife on your social media accounts, however, the use of flash photography is strictly prohibited as it can be harmful to our animals and historical artifacts.
- 8. Use designated areas for snacks and lunches.** Schools groups will have designated picnic areas if you choose to eat lunch at WOW. Our team will help you find the perfect spot for your class to enjoy their lunch break. All drinks and snacks should remain in the concessions or designated lunch areas.
- 9. Teachers and chaperones are responsible for all students.** While acting as a chaperone on a field trip adults should stay with their designated group at all times, this includes inside Bass Pro Shops.

The above behavior guidelines are in place for the protection of your students and Wonders of Wildlife animals. Any group violating these policies may be asked to leave.
